

WARRINGTON HOSPITAL

For the Warrington and Halton Hospitals NHS Trust, a simple building was needed for storing beds though the eventual plan is to turn it into a doctor's recreational room.

The Trust's brief was that they needed a simple building to be built on a small footprint at the rear of the site.

Warrington Hospital is a busy specialist NHS care facility near Manchester that focuses on A&E care, maternity services, stroke and cardiac units, and provides expert care for those undergoing complex surgery pre and post operation.

As a result, the Trust required a versatile storage space and approached us to carry out the design, manufacture, installation, and site works.

The initial priority was to create more space for storing beds, but the plan is to then convert the room into a doctor's mess hall when the beds are reallocated. It was more feasible and environmentally friendly to do this as one building.

THE RESULTS

We built a 10.2 x 9m building complete with lightning, sockets, and several windows to let in natural light.

Whilst unessential for a warehouse, the plan is to repurpose the space for a doctor's mess room means that it's ready to go as soon as the Trust wishes.
