THE PROJECT

We worked with our client to create a modular education building that perfectly suited the needs of the pupils, creating a flexible classroom with multifunctional indoor space. We installed vinyl flooring that can withstand messy activities, and devised an uncomplicated layout so the room is easy for staff to clear.

The modular classroom features lighting and climate control to ensure it is warm in winter and cool in summer, and there are spacious storage and accessible toilet facilities. Bi-folding doors lead to the playground, allowing for free flow play: headteacher Gill Turner described the space as an 'inside-outside' classroom, with classes able to pass seamlessly between the indoor environment and the adjacent outdoor play area.
